The Second International Conference on "The Quran and Science" will be held in December this year, organized by a group of scholars and researchers from both domestic and international institutions, with the support of the International Foundation for Quran and Science Studies (Kowsar), Ferdowsi University of Mashhad, the Academy of Sciences, the International Commission for the Development of Quranic Activities, the Permanent Committee for Scientific and Technological Cooperation of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation, and several other universities in the country.

This conference, in line with the movement to return to the Quran and develop science and technology based on divine teachings, aims to introduce new questions and open new horizons in understanding nature, inspired by the Quran's references. It also pursues the following objectives:
